



Student Guidelines for Online/Streamed Classes

Online/streamed classes are a good way for students to learn. These are some guidelines to in order that these classes run smoothly and are of most benefit for students.

- Make sure that you are in a quiet place, so that you can engage fully.
- Have all required materials available before the class starts.
- Log-on at the start of the class; students logging-on late can be a distraction to others.
- If you are unable to attend a class or you will have to leave before the scheduled end of the class, please contact the teacher in advance of its start time.
- You should log-on sitting at a desk; remain seated at the screen for the entire class – do not move around. It is not appropriate to join a class while in bed.
- Do not have any other apps open, or your phone nearby if using a laptop; they will distract you.
- When logging on, appropriate clothing is required.
- Follow the teachers instructions in relation to muting your microphone and turning on or off your video.
- The teacher will outline the procedure for asking questions during the class, use this method to do so.
- The teacher reserves the right to remove you from an online or streamed class if there is not behaviour conducive to learning.
- As in normal classrooms, students should show respect for teacher and other students in the class at all times.
