Agreed report following the Board of Management meeting held on Monday 11th February 2019.

- The Board met with the student council representatives Shirley Bailey, Oisín Rudge, Briain Baily and Sam Spillane who outlined their ongoing work for the student body and discussed their plans for the rest of the academic year. The Board complimented the student council on their impressive presentation and their invaluable contribution to the school. The Board look forward to meeting with the student council again towards the end of the year.
- The Board noted the appointment of Chris Baker to Assistant Principal 1 position to the school. The Board wish him well as he takes up this middle management position.
- The Board reviewed the Senior Cycle curriculum. It noted there are 23 subjects offered in Leaving Certificate and that the average class size in Form V 5 is 14 and in Form VI is 12.
- The Board heard that Ms. Henry and Ms. O’Riordan are attending Droichead training to equip them in mentoring Newly Qualified Teachers at the school.
- The Board have been working on developing policies for the school. The Anti-bullying and Critical Incident Policy will shortly be sent to stakeholders for review shortly. The Child Safe Guarding Statement and RSE policy are currently under review. The Code of Behaviour policy is scheduled for review over the coming months.
