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## Board of Management Agreed Report

Agreed report following the Board of Management meeting held on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> December 2020:

- The Board heard update reports from representatives of the *Development* and *Finance* sub-committees. The Development committee have had a number of meetings and are continuing to review objectives for the College's Strategic Development Plan.
- The Board also received an update from the Covid Oversight Group. The Group reviewed the Safe Provision of Schooling Checklist. The Covid Oversight Group consists and of Dr Lynch, Dr Gash, Mr Stanley the College's two Lead Worker representatives, Mr Clive Seale and Ms Louise Curtin. The Board extended their gratitude to the LWR's for their excellent work on behalf of the whole school community.
- The Board received notification that a 'Supporting the Safe Provision of Schooling' inspection will be carried out by an inspector from the Department of Education and science (DES) on Wednesday 16th December 2020.
- The Board ratified the appointment of Mr Alex Aherne to the position of Special Needs Assistant (SNA) in the College. The Board sent their congratulations to Mr Aherne and wished him continued success in his new role.
- The Board discussed the upcoming Parent Teacher Meetings which on this occasion will be carried out by phone. They also received details of the Remote Learning trial proposed for Monday 21st and Tuesday 22nd December 2020. These will be remote online learning days and will be invaluable should further lockdowns require remote teaching and learning.
- Dates for the Mock exams were discussed by the Board.
- Several members of the Board completed Board of Management training.
- Dr. Gash shared a presentation on the Protestant fee charging schools and the Minority Faith fee-paying school sector.
- The Board heard details of the amended Transition Year programme and congratulated the students on their efforts to date.
- The Wellbeing Policy and the Guidance Policy are continuing to be updated. The Code of Behaviour is in its final stages and will be reviewed again and discussed at the next meeting.
