INTERNET ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

The School will employ a number of strategies in order to maximise learning opportunities and reduce risks associated with the Internet. These strategies are as follows:

- Class group Internet sessions will be supervised by a teacher.
- Filtering software will be used in order to minimise the risk of exposure to inappropriate material.
- The school will regularly monitor students Internet use.
- Uploading and Downloading on non-approved software will not be permitted.
- Virus protection software will be used and updated on a regular basis.
- The use of personal floppy disks or CD-ROMS in school will not be permitted.
- Students will observe good etiquette on the Internet at all times and will not undertake any actions that may bring the school into disrepute.
- Any student wishing to access the Internet can only do so with the permission from a teacher.

World Wide Web

Students will not visit websites that contain obscene, illegal, hateful or otherwise objectionable materials.

- Students will use the Internet for educational purposes only.
- Students will never disclose or publicise personal information.
- Students will be aware that any usage of the Internet may be monitored for unusual activity and security reasons.

E-mail

Students will use approved class E-mail accounts and only when supervised by a teacher.

Internet chat

Students will not have access to chat rooms, discussion forums or other electronic communication forums if they have not been school approved and without teacher supervision.

Sanctions

Misuse of the Internet may result in disciplinary action, including verbal warnings, withdrawal of access privileges and in extreme cases suspension or expulsion.
